7. (a) Discuss the teaching of John's Gospel on the Holy Spirit. (12 marks)

8. (a) Analyse Paul's teaching on marriage in 1 Corinthians 7: 1-40. (12 marks)
 (b) Discuss the lessons the Church can learn from this teaching. (13 marks)
9. "O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you?" (Gal. 3:1 RSV).
 (a) What prompted Paul to utter such strong words in his letter to the Galatians? (12 marks)
 (b) Discuss Paul's teaching on what makes a person a Christian. (13 marks)
10. (a) Comment on Jeremiah's call to be a prophet. (12 marks)
 (b) Discuss factors that hinder people from responding to God's call. (13 marks)
11. (a) Discuss James' teaching on trials and temptations. (12 marks)
