3. James and John requested Jesus, "let one of us sit at your right and the other at your left in your glory ..." Mark 10: 35-45.
- (a) Comment on this request. *(13 marks)*
- (b) Examine the lessons that Christians learn from Jesus' response to James and John's request. *(12 marks)*
4. (a) Discuss the significance of the Gentiles in the Gospel of Mark. *(12 marks)*
- (b) Examine the role played by foreigners in the spread of Christianity in Uganda today. *(13 marks)*
5. (a) Examine different situations from the book of Mark which show that Jesus concealed His messiahship. *(12 marks)*
- (b) Justify Jesus' concealment of His messiahship. *(13 marks)*
6. (a) Analyse the role of women in Jesus' ministry in the Gospels of Mark and John. *(13 marks)*
- (b) Discuss the contribution of women in the spread of the Gospel in Uganda today. *(12 marks)*
7. (a) Explain the meaning of the cleansing of the Temple in John's Gospel. *(13 marks)*
- (b) Examine the wrong things in the Church today that may require cleansing. *(12 marks)*
8. Discuss the significance of Jesus' conversation with:
  - (a) Nicodemus, *(13 marks)*
  - (b) The Samaritan woman. *(12 marks)*
9. (a) Account for the divisions in the Corinthian Church. *(13 marks)*
- (b) How did Paul deal with these divisions? *(12 marks)*

- 10. (a)** Account for the conflicts between Paul and the Judaizers in his letter to the Galatians. *(13 marks)*
- (b)** What lessons can modern Christians learn about Paul's defense of his apostleship? *(12 marks)*
