4. (a) Examine the causes of domestic violence in modern families in Uganda today. *(12 marks)*
- (b) What Christian advice can you give to modern families to remain stable? *(13 marks)*

5. (a) Account for the increasing rate of joblessness in Uganda today. *(15 marks)*
- (b) As a Christian, how would you advise people in your society to honestly earn a living? *(10 marks)*
6. (a) To what extent have the medical workers observed the professional code of conduct in Uganda today? *(15 marks)*
- (b) Give the problems faced by professionals in your society. *(10 marks)*
7. (a) Discuss the causes of drug addiction in modern society. *(12 marks)*
- (b) Comment on the consequences of drug addiction for the individual and society. *(13 marks)*

8. (a) Examine the consequences of the lust for wealth in Uganda today. *(13 marks)*
(b) Discuss the Christian teaching on the use of wealth. *(12 marks)*
