(b) Discuss the lessons Christians learn from the fall of man in the garden of Eden. *(12 marks)*
2. (a) Account for the call of Abraham. *(13 marks)*
(b) Analyse the ways in which God has shown His love for mankind today. *(12 marks)*
3. (a) Justify the view that Moses' birth and experience in Egypt prepared him for future leadership. *(13 marks)*
(b) What can the current political leaders learn from Moses' leadership? *(12 marks)*
4. (a) Comment on the act of Herem in the book of Deuteronomy. *(13 marks)*
(b) What should be the Christian attitude to the act of Herem? *(12 marks)*

SECTION B
HISTORICAL BOOKS

5. (a) To what extent did Samuel contribute to Saul's rejection by God as King? *(15 marks)*
(b) What lessons can Christians learn from Saul's rejection? *(10 marks)*
6. (a) Examine the consequences of David's adultery with Bathsheba. *(13 marks)*
(b) Give lessons that leaders today can learn from David's act of adultery. *(12 marks)*
7. 'The Temple in Jerusalem was an asset to the people of Israel.' Discuss. *(25 marks)*

SECTION C
PROPHETIC AND WISDOM BOOKS

Answer two questions from this section, one of which should be question 12.

8. (a) Analyse the disagreement prophet Amos had with High Priest Amaziah at Bethel. (Amos 7:7-10). (13 marks)
- (b) What were the consequences of this conflict with Amaziah? (12 marks)
9. Comment on the view that Hosea's family life experience pointed to God's encounter with Israel. (25 marks)
10. (a) Examine the meaning of the parable of the Vineyard in Isaiah's prophecy. (Isaiah 5). (13 marks)
- (b) Analyse the significance of this parable to the New Testament. (12 marks)
11. (a) Discuss Prophet Ezekiel's teaching about corporate sin and guilt. (Ezekiel 18). (15 marks)
- (b) Give lessons that Christians can learn from Ezekiel's teaching. (10 marks)
12. (a) Justify God's condemnation of Job's friends. (13 marks)
- (b) Comment on the lessons that can be drawn from Job's suffering experience. (12 marks)
