4. "...Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all." Mark 10: 43-44. (NIV).  
(a) Analyse the meaning of the above statement. (13 marks)  
(b) In what ways are Church leaders today following this teaching of Jesus? (12 marks)
5. Discuss the ways in which Mark's Gospel is different from that of John. (25 marks)
6. Examine the similarities and differences in the accounts of the crucifixion and death of Jesus in the Gospels of Mark and John. (25 marks)
7. (a) Analyse the significance of Jesus' healing of the man born blind. John 9: 1-12. (13 marks)  
(b) Examine the ways in which Christians today tend to be blind to the teachings of Jesus Christ. (12 marks)
8. Jesus said to them "If any one of you is without sin, let him be the first to throw a stone at her." John 8: 7b. (NIV).  
(a) Explain the implications of this statement. (13 marks)  
(b) What can Christians in Uganda today learn from this incident? (12 marks)
