Cocoa production

Stakeholder in the cocoa sector have taken measures to ensure that the quality of Cameroon cocoa is improved upon. Meeting in kumba to evaluate the previous cocoa season in the country, actors resolved to engage in proper sensitization of farmers to ferment cocoa for at least six days while discouraging the use of tar to dry cocoa.

The two days meeting organized by the Cocoa and office inter-professional council(CCIC) in collaboration with the National cocoa and coffee board aimed at assessing the current cocoa season as well as the implementation of the support for Organisation Marketing(SOM) and in compliance with the new statutory provision of the

CCIC. The meeting that brought together one hundred participants ranging from producers, buyers, delegates of trade an Agriculture, administrative and municipal authorities also resolved to sensitize producers on the need and importance of the market day's operations. According to officials, this will ensure fair competition between operators and fair price for producers.

As the Executive Secretary of CCIC puts it in his address, the marketing of cocoa is still confronted with difficulties with the existence of intermediaries whose activities are not recognized by the relevant authorities, bringing dysfunctionality in the market. This, he went on, explains why CCIC and NCCB are pitting mechanisms in the market operations in accordance with regulations liberalizing the sector.

Officially opening the evaluation meeting for the first Assistant SDO for Meme, Mbua Epolle saluted the organization of an evaluation of the cocoa season to discuss with stakeholders and find solutions to the problems which are affecting the sector. The administrator urged participants to lay emphasis on transparency of the market and declaration of a static and fair remuneration for producers.
