to launch the competitive entrance examination into the **1st Year of the First Cycle** of the Higher Teachers' Training College (ENS) of the University of Maroua for the **2022-2023** academic year.

THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION,

- Mindful of the Constitution;
- Mindful of law n° 2001/005 of 16 April 2001 on the orientation of Higher Education;
- Mindful of decree n° 2008/280 of 09 August 2008 to create the University of Maroua;
- Mindful of decree n° 2008/281 of 09 August 2008 on the administrative and academic organization of the University of Maroua;
- Mindful of decree n° 2008/282 of 09 August 2008 on the administrative and academic organization of the Higher Teachers' Training College (ENS) Maroua;
- Mindful of decree n° 2011/408 of 09 December 2011 to organize the Government;
- Mindful of decree n° 2011/410 of 09 December 2011 to appoint members Government;
- Mindful of decree n° 2012/433 of 01 October 2012 to organize the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful of n°18220053/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 16 March 2022 setting the University calendar of Competitive Entrance Examinations in the Establishments of Cameroon State Universities and Schools under the academic supervision of the MINESUP for the 2022-2023 academic year;
- Mindful of circular n°004/CAB/PM of 10 February 2000 relating to admission into national training schools and recruitment into the Public Service,

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS :

Article 1: A competitive written examination for admission into the **1st year of the First Cycle** in the Higher Teachers' Training College (ENS) of the University of Maroua is launched, for the **2022-2023** academic year, in the following series:

Article 2: (1) The competitive entrance examination is organized in a single session for Cameroonians of both sexes and who are holders of the following certificates: the GCE Advanced Level in at least two (2) subjects including the main subject (major) of the series, and the GCE Ordinary Level obtained in one session with at least four (4) subjects including the main subject (major) of the series ; the Baccalauréat Certificate required for each series solicited; « Religious Knowledge » shall not be taken into consideration.

(2) The table below indicates the type of GCE 'A' Level, the Baccalauréat and the main subject which the candidate must have passed at the GCE 'A' Level to be able to sit for the examination:

Series	Type of Baccalauréat and subjects obtained at the GCE 'A' Level
History	A4 or D History for the GCE 'A'L
Chemistry	C or D Chemistry for the GCE 'A'L
French Language and Literatures of French Expression	A4 French for the GCE 'A'L
Mathematics	C, D, E or TI Mathematics and Further mathematics for the GCE 'A'L
Life and Earth Sciences	C, D or TI Biology or Geology for the GCE 'A'L

Article 3: (1) Foreign candidates may be authorized to sit for the examination under the same academic conditions and based on the number of places available, in conformity with the regulation in force.

(2) Candidates must not be more than **28 years old as from 1st January 2022**. Age waivers will not be granted.

(3) Civil servants are not allowed to apply as external candidates.

Article 4: Candidates' files shall comprise the following documents:

- an application form to sit for the examination, obtainable from the Higher Teachers' Training College (ENS), the examination centers and the regional delegations for Secondary Education. It can be also downloaded from the following MINESUP Internet website: <http://www.minesup.gov.cm> and the Internet website of the University of Maroua : <http://www.univ-maroua.cm> ;
- a certified photocopy of birth certificate, dated not more than six (6) months ago;
- results transcripts of the GCE/OL or the Probatoire and the GCE/AL or the Baccalauréat signed or certified by the competent Examination Boards;
- a certified photocopy of the GCE/AL or the Baccalauréat, or an equivalent diploma/certificate recognized by the Minister of Higher Education, dated not more than six (6) months ago, or a Success Testimonial signed or certified by the competent Examination Boards. Only candidates sitting for the 2022 GCE/AL shall be authorized to write the examination awaiting the required diplomas/certificates; however, where the case arises, their final admission shall be possible only on the presentation of proof of having obtained the required diploma/certificate within the date limits specified by the competent authority;
- a medical certificate issued by a medical doctor working with the public Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically apt to work as a teacher. Notably that he/she has no physiological impairments especially concerning speech, hearing, sight or movement;
- a certificate of non-conviction (bulletin n°3) dated not more than three (03) months ago;
- a receipt showing payment of the sum of **twenty thousand (20 000) CFA Francs** as examination fees, issued by **COMMERCIAL BANK-CAMEROON, Account Number 37160229701-44**. No other mode of payment shall be accepted;
- a large envelop bearing postal stamps respecting current rates and carrying the exact address of the candidate;
- two (2) passport size (4x4) photographs.

Article 5: Candidates who are holders of foreign diplomas/certificates have to present the decision of equivalence issued by the Minister of Higher Education, or the receipt for a diploma equivalence application.

Article 6: Complete files shall be deposited either at the regional delegations for Secondary Education (except for Yaounde where a Filing center shall be set up on the University of Yaounde I Campus) or at the Higher Teachers' Training College (ENS) Maroua (Admissions Service) or at the branch of the University of Maroua located at Kousseri latest **Friday 30th september 2022**.

Article 7: The examination papers will comprise the following:

- a) a mark for school attendance which will account for 30% in the overall assessment;
- b) two written tests which will account for 70% in the overall assessment;

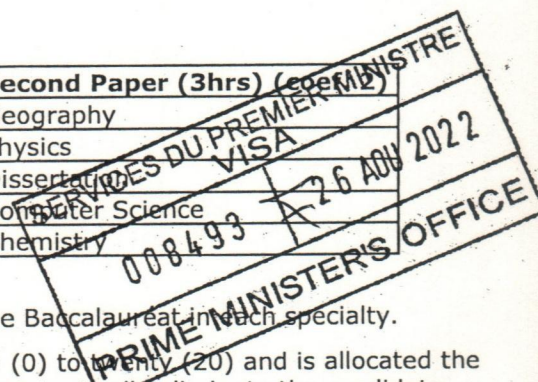
Article 8: The written examination shall be conducted on **Saturday, 08 October 2022** in the following centers: **Bertoua, Douala, Dschang, Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundere and Yaounde**.

Article 9: (1) The written examination is organised as follows:

Series	First Paper (3hrs) (coef. 4)	Second Paper (3hrs) (coef. 2)
History	History	Geography
Chemistry	Chemistry	Physics
French Language and French Literature	French Language	Dissertation
Mathematics	Mathematics	Computer Science
Life and Earth Sciences	Life and Earth Sciences	Chemistry

(2) The examination programmes are those of the GCE/AL or the Baccalauréat in each specialty.

(3) Each examination paper written has a mark range from zero (0) to twenty (20) and is allocated the coefficients indicated above. Any mark below five (5) on twenty (20) shall automatically eliminate the candidate.



Article 10: The mark for school attendance shall be allocated based on the following criteria:

- the candidate's age;
- the number of years spent in secondary education;
- marks obtained at the GCE/OL or the Probatoire and the GCE/AL or the Baccalauréat.

Article 11: (1) After due deliberation, the jury shall establish, according to series and in order of merit, the tentative list of candidates for final admission.

(2) The candidate's performance in the final admission cannot be carried forward from one academic year to another.

(3) The final results will be published by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

Article 12: Fraudulent admission following failure to enforce the required condition for diploma, grade, age or seniority exposes the candidate concerned to automatic expulsion at any time without any due form and procedure.

Article 13: The composition of the jury cited in articles 11 shall be established in a special text by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, in conformity with the regulation in force.

Article 14: The examination fees mentioned in article 4 are non-refundable.

Article 15: The Rector of the University of Maroua, the Director for University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the Higher Teachers' Training College (ENS) Maroua are, each in his sphere, charged with the implementation of this order which shall be recorded and published in English and in French wherever need arises.
