To launch the Competitive Common Entrance Examination for the recruitment of Student-Teachers into **Year One of the First Cycle** of the Higher Technical Teachers' Training College (HTTTC) of the University of Buea in Kumba, for the 2022/2023 academic year.

THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION,

- Mindful of the Constitution;
- Mindful of Law n° 005 of 16th April 2001 bearing on the orientation of Higher Education;
- Mindful of Decree n° 93/026 of 19th January 1993 to create Universities;
- Mindful of Decree n° 93/027 of 19th January 1993 fixing common dispositions in State Universities, modified and supplemented by Decree n° 2005/342 of 10th September 2005;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2011/408 of 09th December 2011 to organize the Government;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2011/410 of 09th December 2011 to appoint members of Government;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2012/433 of 1st October 2012 to organize the Ministry of Higher Education;
- Mindful of Decree n° 93/034 of 19th January 1993 on the administrative organization of the University of Buea;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2012/333 of 29th June 2012 appointing the Vice-Chancellor and Rectors of some State Universities;
- Mindful of Decree n° 2014/090 of 7th March 2014 to create the Higher Technical Teachers' Training College Kumba, of the University of Buea;
- Mindful of Decision n° 004/CAB/PM of 10th February 2000 on admission into national training institutions and on recruitment into the civil service;
- Mindful of Order N°18220053/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 16th March 2022 fixing the calendar of competitive entrance examinations into institutions of State Universities for 2022-2023 academic year;

DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive common entrance examination for the recruitment of student teachers into Year One of the First Cycle of the Higher Technical Teachers' Training College (HTTTC) of the University of Buea in Kumba, has been launched for the 2022/2023 academic year in the following departments and options:

Article 2: (1) The examination shall be organized in one sitting for Cameroonians of both sexes, holders of the Baccalauréat required for the option solicited, or GCE A/L in at least two papers and GCE O/L with pass in at least four subjects, excluding "Religious Knowledge."

(2) The table below shows the required certificates to qualify for the Competitive

Civil Engineering and Forestry Techniques	Building Construction	Baccalauréat C, D, E, TI or GCE A/L in at least two of the following papers (Pure Maths, Further Maths, Computer Sciences, Applied Maths, Physics, Chemistry and Biology). Baccalauréat Technique: F1, F2, F3, F4, F5, BT-MEB, BT-IS, GCE A/L Technical in Building Construction or any higher diploma in the option.
Tourism and Hospitality Management	Tourism	-GCE A/L in Sciences or Arts and Baccalauréat in any Series or any higher diploma in the option.
Law	Law	Baccalauréat or GCE A/L in Sciences or Arts.

Article 3: (1) Foreign candidates may be allowed to sit for the examination in the same academic conditions within the limits of the available places, in conformity with the regulations in force.

(2) Candidates who are not civil servants should not be more than 29 years old as of 1st January 2022.



Article 4: The registration procedure is as follows:

- Present yourself to any Express Union agency for payment;
- Collect your receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA;
- Go online and enter your Express Union transaction ID number for registration at the web address <http://www.registration.htttckumba.com> in order to obtain an acceptance slip and submit your clear scanned documents in **PDF format**.

The scanned documents to be submitted includes:

- A certified true photocopy of the birth certificate dated not more than six (6) Months;
- Transcripts of Probatoire or GCE O/L certified by the competent authorities;
- A certified photocopy of Baccalauréat or GCE A/L dated not more than six (6) months.
- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer from the Administration testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching. It should particularly specify that the candidate does not suffer from serious physiological deficiencies in his diction, hearing, sight and motricity;
- A certificate of non-conviction dated not more than three months;
- A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) FCFA at any EXPRESS UNION agency. **No other form of payment shall be accepted;**
- An authorization to sit for the examination issued by the ministry of origin for civil servants.

NB: Absence of any of the above-mentioned documents lead to an elimination for the exam.

Article 5:(1) Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either the equivalence or the receipt showing that they applied for the equivalence of their diplomas or certificates. The Order granting equivalence and the receipt are issued by the Minister of Higher Education.

(2) In case of their final admission after success in the examination, the candidate will be

subject to the presentation of the said equivalence within the deadline set by the competent authorities.

Article 6: Complete files should be submitted **online** during registration, latest **24st September 2022**.

Article 7: (1) The examination shall comprise:

A. A written paper (70% of the total assessment);

B. Study of files (30% of the total assessment);

Article 8: The written examination will take place on **Saturday 01 October 2022 at 8 a.m.** in the following examination centers: **Buea, Douala, Yaounde and Kumba.**

Article 9: (1) The written examinations will be in the departments and options listed below:

The syllabi of the competitive entrance examination in each option are the same as in the Baccalaureate or GCE A/L Programs or equivalence.

Article 10: Written examinations are scored on 20 points. Any score below 05 points is eliminatory.

Article 11: The study of candidates' files will be based on:

- The candidate's age;
- The number of years spent in Secondary Education;
- Transcripts of Probatoire, GCE O/L and that of Baccalaureate or GCE A/L.

The final results shall be published by the Minister of Higher Education after deliberations by the jury.

Article 12: The composition of the jury mentioned in Article 11 will be the prerogative of the Minister of Higher Education.

Article 13: The Vice-Chancellor of the University of Buea, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the Higher Technical Teachers' Training College (H.T.T.T.C) of the University of Buea in Kumba, each in his/her own sphere, are responsible for the implementation of this order which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
